OVERVIEW

Join us on this one of a kind adventure to visit the Capilano Suspension Bridge. The bridge spans 450 feet across and 230 feet above Capilano River. Receive proof that you crossed with an “I Made It” certificate available at guest services. There is an eco-walk, “Treetops Adventure” for guests of all ages that goes from one colossal Douglas Fir tree to another on a series of seven suspended cable bridges up to 100 feet. Join a friendly nature guide and explore the West Coast Rainforest or take a stroll through the park with a turn-of-the-century costumed guide for an overview of the park and its colorful history. Other attractions include the Story Centre, lively Spirit



Stage, colorful Totem Pole Park, a cultural center and Elizabeth’s English Gardens.

Whether you’re a thrill seeker who wants to hang 230 feet above a rushing river or a nature lover who likes to keep the group planted firmly beneath your feet, the Capilano Suspension Bridge Park offers both an adrenaline rush like no other and the soothing sounds of the forest and crisp mountain air.
